Dear Jane, Anne, and Margaret:

Thank you for meeting with our executive team on February 10 to discuss various issues including Pesticide Use Near Schoolsites regulations. As was shared during our meeting, all of the actions included in your February 4 letter would require regulation. The Department, along with the county agricultural commissioners (CACs), is committed to protecting children and schoolsites from pesticide exposure and the enforcement of the Pesticide Use Near Schoolsites regulations. DPR is actively working on identifying immediate actions in close coordination with CACs to enhance the tools available for tracking compliance with the Pesticide Use Near Schoolsites regulations. This includes increasing outreach to growers and applicators.

The Department has issued guidance to CACs for distribution at permitting times, and during Spray Safe and grower meeting events to increase compliance. We also will evaluate regulatory options to clarify field application reporting. In addition, we are selecting for follow up a few schools that appear from the PUR data you shared to potentially have been most impacted by nearby pesticide applications. Our objective is to better understand whether the applications reported during the 6am-to-6pm school day cover fields partially or entirely within the schoolsite regulation buffer zone, and if partially, whether the application to the partially covered field took place before, during or after the school day.
